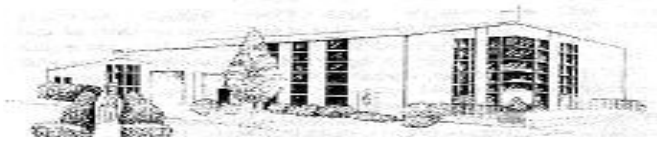

**A Message from Your Parish Council: These are some of the topics that were discussed at our last parish council meeting on Thursday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2017. In the future, we will continue to bring to you the items brought up for discussion at our meetings.**

Why is the Deacon leading the Prayer of the Faithful? The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states that, if a deacon is present at the mass, he should lead the faithful in praying the General Intercessions. If no deacon is present at the mass, a Proclaimer of the Word or a member of the Choir may lead the people in prayer.

Coming soon: Continued training for our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist and our Readers. The Archdiocese of New York has provided materials to help prepare the faithful to serve in these very important ministries. If you are interested in becoming an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist or a Reader, keep an eye out for the training dates that will be posted in our parish bulletin. Everyone who is currently involved in these ministries will be asked to attend. There will be separate dates for the two ministries.

For our 9:30am and 11:15am Sunday masses at Infant Saviour, we will be reducing the number of chalices containing the Precious Blood during communion. The chalice in the church hall will be removed. This decision was made because most of the Precious Blood in that chalice was not partaken of and had to be consumed by the Extraordinary Ministers, Deacon and Priest. If anyone who is sitting in the church hall would still like to partake of the Precious Blood, you can simply step into the main church and visit the minister with the chalice closest to the church hall. This change is scheduled to take place starting with the beginning of Advent, December 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Get ready for the Renew and Rebuild Day of Commitment! Our weekend masses on November 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> will provide anyone who has not yet contributed to the Renew and Rebuild Campaign a chance to do so. **READ : Parish Pay** is now LPi which is an alternative means of fulfilling your stewardship commitment to Infant Saviour Church that benefits both you and the parish. It is considered as the best means available of supporting our Parish. **For those who are using ParishPay, PLEASE NOTE THAT** all has been transferred from ParishPay to LPi -- you do not need to do anything unless you want to change the amount you are giving, account it is being taken from or enroll into the program. *All information remains confidential and secure.* Website link has changed. *You do need now to log on to infantsaviour.org* and go to bottom of first page and link onto the website provided. Once on the site please log on using your email and your password that you have been using for ParishPay, they will then ask you a few questions to authenticate yourself. You can also do this by phone. Phone number is 1-800-950-9952. If you run into an error message please call the Parish Office or the phone number for LPi. As in the past, the funds you designate are deducted from your account and directly credited to Infant Saviour Church. Currently, we have 73 families in our Parish participating in ParishPay and we would like to grow that number. Enrollment is easy, friendly, secure, confidential and most of all there is no cost to you for using LPi.

**RENEW & REBUILD 2017**

On Thursday, October 5, Cardinal Dolan publically announced the Renew & Rebuild capital campaign, a \$200 million archdiocesan-wide initiative that greatly benefits the parishes and ministries of the Archdiocese of New York. 40% of our parishes have participated in the campaign already. Rebuilding Our Church -- The Archdiocese of New York has embarked on a campaign to renew and rebuild our Church physically and spiritually. Due to the hard work and dedication of pastors, lay leaders, and parishioners, the campaign has raised over \$116 million thus far. The vast majority of the \$177 million raised by parishes will stay within parishes, These funds will have a huge impact across the archdiocese, particularly for parish projects and capital needs. 74% of funds raised by parishes stay within parishes for capital improvement projects, and 26% supports: 10,000,000 for extraordinary capital projects for needy parishes, \$4,000,000 for Evangelization and lay leadership formation, \$8,000,000 for Catholic High Schools, \$4,000,000 for Catholic Charities and \$14,000,000 for St. Patrick's Cathedral restoration.

Over the last several months we have been meeting with parishioners. I am happy to announce that build the foundation of this campaign by making their sacrificial pledges so generously. The total pledges raised at present are **\$411,295.00.** (20% of our families) We are at 63% of our assigned goal. have pledged sacrificially towards this campaign. The average gift at this point is around \$8281.00.

My Choice is a non-profit organization which is a haven of hope in Middletown or New Windsor which effectively serves women faced with unplanned pregnancy. They provide caring, safe and non-judgmental support to girls and women who are faced with unplanned pregnancies.
