Renew + Rebuild – Official Announcement of Parish Capital Campaign

Today, we are formally announcing the Renew + Rebuild Campaign at Infant Saviour Parish. Renew+ Rebuild is a \$200 million initiative for the parishes of the Archdiocese of New York. **Thus, the total goal of this campaign for the entire Archdiocese will be \$200,000,000.**

Parishes all over the Archdiocese of New York after the “Making All Things New” phase, are given the opportunity to renew and strengthen in increasing participation, programs, facility development, etc. in the parish church. **The largest portion of the campaign goal will be allocated directly to individual parish needs.** The needs in the parishes of our archdiocese widely vary. Some require renovations and repairs to make facilities more conducive to worship and provide easier access for the elderly and disabled. Others are eager to update technology; install cleaner and greener solutions to powering, heating and cooling their facilities in accordance with our Holy Father's reminder that we have a responsibility to better care for the earth; or establish endowments to secure the long-term sustainability of the parish. The campaign will provide an opportunity for parishes to identify what their priorities are and to plot out the ways in which they will better serve Christ in the 21st century.

Church of Infant Saviour Improvement Projects

Past Generations have sacrificed to build this beautiful church of Infant Saviour and its Mission Church, Our Lady of the Valley. It is our turn to safeguard it! **As we all know the parish is the center of religious and spiritual life. It is our home, where we convene for daily and weekly Mass, yearly holidays and holy days, the sacraments that affirm our commitment to our faith, and religious education for our children, strengthening the faith of our adults and children.**

The goal for Renew = Rebuild for our parish is \$653,000. Through Renew & Rebuild we are planning to replace the roof of Church and Church Hall, Pave the Parking lots of Infant Saviour Church and the Pre-K, Renovations to the Churches and Church hall: reupholstering Church Hall chairs, tiling, and renovating the stained glass, to convert Pre-K into a Rectory and to replace gutters in the Church and Church Hall.

We have to understand this archdiocesan wide spread capital campaign as a blessing to our parish since we have to do so much of renovations and updating to our Church buildings. Therefore, this effort will help our faith community to renovate our Church for the present and to bring the Church of the Infant Savior into the future. This appeal allows us to inform the members of your parish about our mission work in Egypt. As you may imagine, our missions in places like Egypt are in great need of support. The sisters work in several houses, providing education for children, teenagers, and young women. They also have a home for girls with special needs. Since most of the girls come from poor families, the sisters also take care of the families by giving them some assistance. As you may know, Egypt is not economically stable at present. For this reason missionaries do not receive much help from the local people who very often themselves lack even basic necessities. Thank you, Fr. Rodrigo, for giving us this opportunity to speak at Infant Saviour and share with you about our mission in Egypt. Please be assured of our prayers for all of you as well!"
